MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS

The Chamber's membership year runs July 1–June 30, annually. Choose the category that best fits your business' needs; memberships may be secured online at centralnh.org.

BUSINESSES

- 1-3 Employees

For small and/or seasonal businesses with 1-3 FTEs.

- 4-49 Employees

For businesses and organizations with 4-49 FTEs.

- 50+ Employees

For large businesses or organizations with 50+ FTEs.

Employees mean full-time equivalent employees (FTEs), including owners, managers, and independent contractors.

Seasonal or part-time staff: Each individual is counted as half a full-time staff person. (Two part-time employees equal one FTE; Two seasonal workers employed fewer than six months/year equal one FTE).

NON-PROFITS

For non-profit and not-for-profit organizations (e.g., 501(c)(3) and 501(c)(6) entities).

MUNICIPALITIES

For city, town, and village governments.

MULTIPLE BUSINESS LOCATIONS

Businesses with multiple locations that should be listed separately in the CNHCC Member Directory and other publications will be subject to an additional fee per location.

INSTALLMENT PAYMENTS

Businesses facing COVID-19 hardship can opt-in to an installment payment plan. These memberships cannot be processed via our online payment processor; please contact the Chamber to set up a two- or four-installment payment schedule.
